The Mayor called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and asked the Deputy Mayor to lead the group in the pledge of allegiance.

Ken Braverman, of Hall Keen, has hired Janet Sambolian as the Downtown Community Building and introduced her to the Council during public comment period.

Councilor Picard makes a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Councilor Mahoney seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0-0.

Councilor Picard makes a motion to approve the accounts payable. Councilor Mahoney seconds the motion. 4-0-0.

Councilor Picard makes a motion to pay the Vermont Chief's Dues only if it has been noted as not a duplicate. Councilor Desautels seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0-0.

Mr. Nadeau presented his desire to be reimbursed for damages to his vehicle as a result of a potential missing manhole cover. The Council requested that more information be obtained, such as the deductible and the insurance limits.

Councilor Picard introduced the motion to designate handicapped parking at 96 West Spring Street.

10 Council on the Telecom Committee's activities and about the Housing Roundtable discussion that was had at  
11 City Hall, including a request to better enforce City Code.
