In partnership with its free lunch program, THRIVE's Youth Enrichment Program seeks to ensure that all children in Winooski are well-fed, active, and engaged throughout the summer months.

Q. Why is there now a fee for the Enrichment Program?

A. The fee helps cover the cost of the program, which is largely funded by grants and donations. The true cost per participant is approximately \$500 or 4 times what a Winooski resident is asked to contribute. Put into perspective, the requested participant contribution amounts to \$1-\$3/day, depending on family income.

Q. If I can not pay the full participation fee, can my child still participate?

A. In order to make THRIVE affordable for all families, the cost of participation is sliding scale, with built-in discounts for multiple child families. However, if you require further assistance, you should contact Bob DiMasi at 655-1392, and he will make alternative arrangements. We promise that no child will be left out of the program due to financial hardship.

Q. If my child is not a THRIVE participant, can he/she still receive free meals through the food program?

A. Yes, anyone in Winooski 18 or under is eligible.
